Installation

This plugin should be installed in the usual way using the e107 plug-in manager. It has been tested with version .78. I can make no guarantee that it will work with any other version of e107.

Drop the suggestions_menu folder into the 107 plugins folder and go to the plugin manager and install it.

Go to configuration and configure the plug-in. You will also need to create categories. If you want the menu shown go to menus in the main admin area and activate it. You can also use the List New and Recent menus. Go to that plugin to configure.
